getting out there and bagging those nasty Caltrops.

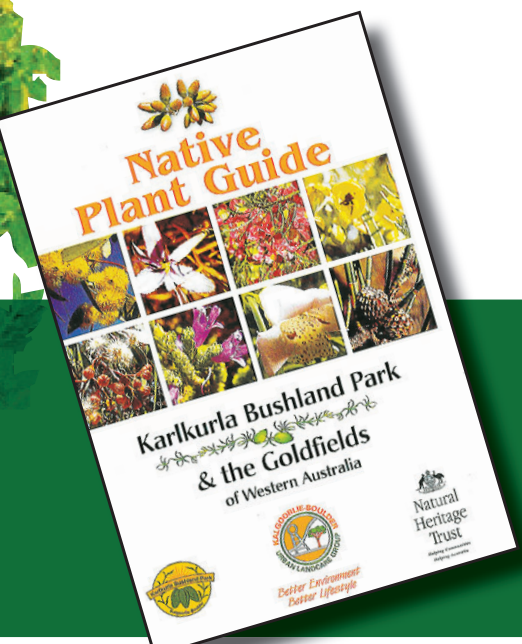

### WHAT IS CALTROP?

Caltrop is an annual, rapidly spreading noxious weed with small yellow flowers that produce seeds with very prickly spines. Caltrop

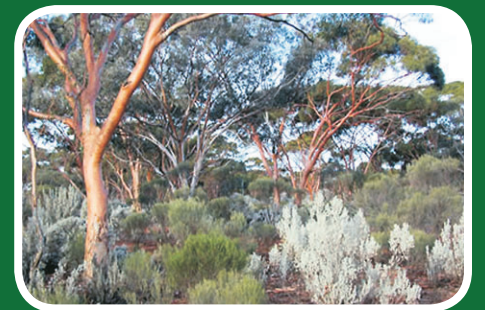
seeds can remain dormant in the soil for 4-5 years and usually germinate after summer rain. Nasty caltrop prickles will stick to virtually anything they come in contact with and puncture feet, bike tyres and shoes. Take action against this wicked weed threatening the feet of adults, children and pets alike.
