## Water Saving Tips

Summer is the time of year when we certainly become more aware of just how precious our water is. By following the tips listed below, you will be helping to save water.

- Air conditioners use a lot of water. Air conditioner bleeds should be set to the recommended 6 litres per hour. Remember to turn your air conditioner off before you go out.
- Keep it short in the shower, or fit a low use water rose. A normal shower uses about 25 litres of water per minute.
- Operate dishwashers only when they are full.
- Washing machines also use a lot of water. As with dishwashers, only use when you have a full load and use the suds saver option. Front loading washing machines use less water than top loaders.
- Check for worn tap washers. Don't run taps while rinsing dishes, washing fruit and vegies or cleaning your teeth.
- Water is wasted when cold water is flushed out of the hot water pipe. Catch it in containers and use it on the garden.
