DISCOVER OUR LOCAL ENVIRONMENT

New to the Goldfields? Or not so new? Why not get out into our Goldfields environment and visit some of the following locations.

Karlkurla Bushland Park:-

Gate access off Riverina Way, Hannan's (Blue directional sign from Graeme Street at Nankiville Road - Hannan's Primary School is on the corner).

Facilities:- Covered shelter, gravel walk trail (4km), bush toilet, picnic tables located every 200m along walk trail.

- Remember no cars (except for authorised vehicles) are permitted in the park.
- If you are walking your dog - have them on a lead and carry a dog tidy bag with you.
- KBULG recommends drinking water be carried into the park.
- There are no rubbish bins in the park - Please take all rubbish home with you.

Remember it is illegal to pick any native plant material in WA.
